Books must be selected from the "Booklist for Board Members" located on the MSBA website under Board Development. Exceptions are by advance permission only.

Credit Requirement: Strand credit is awarded for participation in MSBA events such as conference concurrent sessions. Up to two credits may be earned by reading one or two additional books above the reading requirement. Attach the Credit Form for Additional Reading found on the MSBA website under Board Development. One credit may be earned by attending two board meetings in other districts during the year of your application and completing the Credit Verification Form for each meeting, available on the MSBA website. Strand credits are also earned for participation in Delegate Assembly, online training, whole board workshops, board self-evaluation and webinars.
