2018–2019 New Board Member Training Schedule



Missouri law (§ 162.203, RSMo.) requires that all newly elected school board members complete orientation training within their first year of service.

MSBA's Certified Board Member (CBM) Essential Training addresses the mandated content areas and is based on research in effective board governance.

For nearly 60 years, MSBA has provided education, training, policy, advocacy and financial support services to both new and veteran school board members and their districts. When surveyed, experienced and new board members agree: to become an effective board member, get MSBA's CBM Essential Training as quickly as possible.

Half of the training is delivered online. After board members register for a classroom date, they will be provided access to the online training 5 weeks prior to the classroom date. They should complete the online training **BEFORE** attending the one day of classroom training, which begins promptly at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 6:30 p.m. Additional details regarding the online training will be provided with your CBM registration confirmation. Registration will be closed one week prior to the classroom date to allow ample time to complete the required online training. A minimum of 12 registrations is required per class.
