



Two Year Terms Open in Odd-Numbered Regions: 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15 & 17

To be eligible to serve on the MSBA Board of Directors a person must:

- Be a member of an Active Member Board.
- Served at least two years on their local Board of Education.
- Nominated and approved by action of their respective local Board of Education.
(MSBA Bylaws, Article 4 – Board of Directors, Section 1 – Qualifications; Section 4 – Nomination/Election)

Responsibilities:

- Serve on the Missouri School Boards' Association Board of Directors.
- Have supervision, control and direction of the affairs of the Association.
- Establish policies or determine changes therein within the limits of the Bylaws, statement of beliefs and resolutions of the Association and actively pursue the purposes of the Association.
- Have discretion in the disbursement of Association funds, and shall adopt such rules and regulations for the conduct of its business as deemed advisable.
- Attend quarterly Board of Director meetings (January, April, July and October).
- Attend Legislative Forum, Regional Meetings, Regional SBAN Meetings, Leadership Summit and MSBA Annual Conference.
- Serve as an alternate for the Regional Executive Committee Chair.
- Work collaboratively with the region's Regional Executive Committee Chair, Staff Liaison and Field Representative to support and promote the purpose and goals of MSBA, and to mobilize local school board members in the region to be enthusiastic advocates for public education.
