## District Highlights

Crawford County R-I School District is currently undergoing facility improvements including a brand new track to support our strong Track & Field program, along with district safety improvements and other facility upgrades.

Crawford County R-I includes three campuses in two locations in the city limits of Bourbon.

Bourbon Elementary (BES) is a pre-k to 4<sup>th</sup> grade campus, and is connected to Bourbon Middle School (BMS) which is a 5-8<sup>th</sup> grade campus. We also are one of the few districts to have a Missouri Head Start program located inside our Elementary School.

Bourbon High School (BHS) boasts a great Agricultural program and is looking to implement a STEM program in the near future.

BHS works closely with an area technical school to provide career skills to our students, and we offer dual college credits through an area community college. Thanks to the A+ program and these relationships, our students are able to get a head start on their post-secondary education and career plans.



## Community Highlights

Crawford County R-I school district is located in Bourbon, MO, just 45 minutes from both the Greater St. Louis area to the east and Fort Leonard Wood to the west. Bourbon is 30 minutes from Rolla, home of the Missouri University of Science and Technology (Missouri S&T), one of the top engineering schools in the nation, and is surrounded by major manufacturing in the aerospace, technology, consumer products, and apparel industries.

Bourbon is the definition of a small town. With a town population of fewer than 3,000 people and no stop lights, it offers a relaxing atmosphere that caters to summer tourism thanks to the Meramec River and camping. Agriculture is a big part of the area economy, and our community is surrounded by picturesque farmland.

The City of Bourbon recently made improvements to the city park including new playground equipment and a new basketball court to complement the great walking trail and pavilions.

Our community has great support from local volunteer organizations like the Bourbon Boosters, Bourbon PTO, Bourbon Athletic Association, and Bourbon Economic Development Group, all of which help to ensure fun activities and support in the community.
