Community Highlights

The Raymore-Peculiar School District is located 20 minutes south of Kansas City. The district, which covers 94 square miles, includes the communities of Raymore and Peculiar; small portions of Lee's Summit, Belton and Lake Winnebago; and some unincorporated areas of Cass County. The district serves a mix of suburban and rural areas. Cass County remains one of the fastest growing areas in the state. Commercial development is following the residential growth throughout the district. U.S. I-49 includes four exits within the district, providing easy access to the rest of the KC metro and regional transportation systems. The district is currently engaged in a long-range facility planning process to plan for future growth.

The Raymore-Peculiar School District is a destination district for families and staff alike. Ray-Pec continues to grow, with nearly 6,500 students in grades PK-12. Community support is strong, as recently demonstrated by the approval of a 2016 bond issue and a 2018 operating levy increase. The current strategic plan places an emphasis on success ready students, high quality staff, and financial responsibility.



The district offers a wide range of academic opportunities for students, along with excellent co-curricular and extra-curricular programs. In addition to the various on-campus programs, students can also access programs at Cass Career Center, Summit Tech Academy and Southland CAPS. The district has consistently performed at a high level, earning more than 98% of APR points over each of the past four years.
