## Community Attributes

The Montgomery County R-II district is made up of several communities. Montgomery City is the largest, with 2,500 residents, and is five miles north of I-70 about halfway between the St. Charles/St. Louis metropolitan area and Columbia. The city has three parks which have picnic areas, basketball and tennis courts, playground equipment, and baseball/softball fields. A 9-hole golf course is also available.

The other communities in the district include New Florence (760 pop., on I-70 between Montgomery City and Hermann), Jonesburg (700 and growing, ten miles west of Warrenton on I-70), Bellflower (425, in the northeast section of the district), High Hill (230, on I-70 between Jonesburg and New Florence), Danville, Mineola, and Buell.

Farming and agri-business are major contributors to the local economy.

New manufacturing plants have recently been completed and/or are presently under construction throughout the district. Just a 90-minute drive from Montgomery City is the Lake of the Ozarks recreational area. Its shoreline of more than 1,150 miles offers boating, camping, parasailing, water-skiing and much more.



## District Attributes

The Montgomery County R-II School District serves 1,207 students. The district encompasses 322 square miles and includes a high school, a middle school, and two elementary buildings. The high school/middle school complex is located just south of Montgomery City. The elementary buildings are located in the towns of Jonesburg and Montgomery City.

The district passed a \$14.5 million General Obligation bond in 2013. With the passage of this bond, the district was able to remodel existing buildings as well as build new constructions at all four buildings.
