Guidelines for Placement on the Salary Schedule

1. Teachers will be given up to thirteen years teaching experience for successful teaching in an accredited public or private elementary and/or secondary school system.
2. Horizontal placement will be determined by graduate hours and degrees above the Bachelor's degree. All graduate hours and degrees must be approved prior to advancement on the salary schedule.
3. Master's programs that require 45 or more graduate hours will be placed at the MS+16 column. An additional 16 graduate hours will move the individual to the MS +32 column.
4. Teachers beginning employment with the district after the 2006-07 school year will be excluded from the shaded areas in the BS and BS+16 columns.
5. Step level does not indicate years of experience.

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
