The La Monte R-IV School District has about 335 students in grades PK-12, and the district has a staff of about 55 employees. The district consists of a preschool, elementary building and a junior high-high school building that are conveniently at the one location. Both the elementary school and high school participate in PBIS to support a positive school culture. The District operates on a four-day school week calendar, which began in the 2019-2020 school year.

The La Monte R-IV School District is a member of the Kaysinger Conference and is an A+ school. Students have the opportunity to participate in athletics, music, band, and many other student organizations and clubs. The district has seen many upgrades in the area of technology and devices available to the students. The district consistently focuses on student achievement, and also invests in the quality professional development of the staff.



Community Attributes

The La Monte R-IV School District is located in the West-Central part of Missouri. It is conveniently located right on Highway 50 about 75 miles east of Kansas City between Sedalia and Warrensburg. This central location allows for easy access to many of the attractions of Missouri. The district is located in the city of La Monte, which has a population of about 1,200 people, and the district includes many rural families as well.

The district is proud of the relationship between the school, parents, and community. The support provided by the parents, community members, and the local foundation provides many opportunities for student and district success. Most recently, a bond issue was passed, which resulted in the construction of a new preschool in 2019 and other campus improvements.
