- The Louisiana R-II school district has 726 students PK-12, and 120 staff members. The district is located on 2 campuses. Pk-5 in one location, the other location consists of 6-8 and 9-12 in 2 buildings along with the central office. The Louisiana R-II school district is a member of the Eastern Missouri Conference and an A+ school. A variety of sports and organizations are offered to the students. The district has seen many upgrades to facilities, HVAC, and technology in the past few years by passing a no tax increase bond issue in 2017.

Community Attributes

Louisiana R-II is in rural Pike County on the Mississippi River just south of Hannibal and 70 miles north of St. Louis. Louisiana has a population of about 3,200.

Pike-Lincoln Tech Center provides vocational and technical training for students and adults. The district has a strong relationship with parents and the community.

Pike County Memorial Hospital in Louisiana offers several specialists and primary doctors along with the county's only emergency room. PCMH has an outstanding physical therapy department that assists with athletic training at the area schools.

Uniquely for a small community, Louisiana has over 15 buildings in the downtown area on the National Registry of Historic Places, with many more dating back to the mid and early 1800s. Tourist attractions include Route 79 Mural City, St. Louis University Henry Lay Center, John B. Henderson Riverview Park, Louisiana Riverfront Park, and the Louisiana Historical Museum. Major employers include Dyno Nobel, All Parts, PCMH, and Speed Commerce. There are many locally owned and operated small businesses within the community as well.
