

**MISSOURI SCHOOL BOARDS' ASSOCIATION**  
**DELEGATE ASSEMBLY**  
**SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING**  
**JUNE 11, 2022**

- CALL TO ORDER** The Spring 2022 Semi-Annual meeting of the Delegate Assembly of the Missouri School Boards' Association was called to order at 4:00 p.m. on June 11, 2022, at the St. Charles Convention Center, St. Charles, Missouri by MSBA President Nancy Masterson, Camdenton R-III.
- GREETINGS & FLAG SALUTE** The President greeted all delegates and asked Gary Grigsby, Missouri Department Commander of the American Legion to led them in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.
- INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS** The President introduced the MSBA Executive Director, Melissa Randol. Then the President introduced the following officers of MSBA:

  - Ruth Johnson, Vice President, Raymore-Peculiar
  - Linda Daugherty, MSBA Immediate Past President, Nixa
- Next the members of the MSBA Board of Directors as well as the MSBA Advocacy Staff were asked to stand and be recognized.
- PARLIAMENTARIAN** The chair introduced the parliamentarian for this meeting, Gary Grigsby of Warrensburg R-VI.
- CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE REPORT** The Chair introduced the members of the Credentials Committee: Jonathan Russell, Ricky Vonallmen, Martha Resinger, and Bill Duncan. Jonathan Russell, Chair of the Credentials Committee gave the report of the committee indicating that 83 voting delegates were present. On behalf of the committee, he moved that the voting delegates registered with the Credentials Committee at the beginning of this meeting be the official voting members of this Delegate Assembly. The motion was unanimously adopted by a show of hands.
- RULES OF ORDER** On behalf of the Board of Directors Natalie Vowell, St. Louis City, moved that the Delegate Assembly Rules of Order be approved. The vote was taken, and the rules were approved by the required two-thirds (2/3rds) vote by a unanimous show of hands.
- AGENDA** On behalf of the Board of Directors Georgia Jarman, Holden R-III, moved that the agenda be approved. The vote was taken, and the agenda was approved by a unanimous show of hands.
- TIMEKEEPER** The President then introduced Keith Rabenberg, Brentwood School District, who served as Timekeeper.

The next item of business was the Report of the Nominating Committee. The President read from Article V, Section 5 of the MSBA Bylaws regarding nomination and election.

The President then indicated that Ray Murphy, Richards R-V and MSBA President-elect would assume office as President at the conclusion of this Igniting Great Ideas Summit.

Linda Daugherty, Immediate Past President, and Chair of the Nominating Committee, gave the report of the committee indicating the following nominees for office:

There was no objection and so by a show of hands Ruth Johnson was elected MSBA President-elect and Patti Quessenberry was elected MSBA Vice President.

<b>OUTGOING PRESIDENT'S REMARKS</b>	At this juncture, Nancy Masterson, outgoing President of MSBA, addressed the Delegate Assembly with her remarks.
<b>EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REMARKS</b>	The President then introduced MSBA Executive Director, Melissa Randol spoke to the assembly about the needs of the children in Missouri and the activities of MSBA. Randol introduced John McDonald with the Jefferson County Colorado School District as their Emergency Response & Safety Program leader who has most recently joined the National Council on School Safety Leadership of Consortium of State School Boards' Associations (COSSBA) for his comments on school safety nationwide.
<b>CONSORTIUM OF STATE SCHOOL BOARDS' ASSOCIATIONS (COSSBA)</b>	The President then introduced Linda Daugherty, MSBA Immediate Past Present and charter member representative for an update on the establishment and progress of COSSBA.
<b>INSTALLATION OF 2022 - 2023 MSBA PRESIDENT</b>	President, Nancy Masterson, Camdenton R-III swore incoming President, Ray Murphy, Richards R-V into office as the 2022 - 2023 President.
<b>INCOMING PRESIDENTS REMARKS</b>	Ray Murphy, incoming MSBA President, led the assembly in showing their appreciation to outgoing President Nancy Masterson with a proclamation from the Missouri Senate and a plaque from MSBA. He then introduced Gail Griswold, Board President, Camdenton R-III for remarks of appreciation for Nancy's years of service to the Camdenton Board of Education.
